By this order, five contempt petitions i.e COCP-1442-2019, 2219-2020, 1737-2020, 2247-2020 and 1942-2019 shall stand disposed of.

All the above contempt petitions have been filed complaining willful disobedience of the order dated 11.03.2019 passed in CWP-502-2016.

Learned State counsel has submitted that the order dated 11.03.2019 stands recalled by an order dated 28.07.2021, which is extracted as under:-

“Having considered the submissions made by the learned counsel for the parties and keeping in view the pleadings which have come on record especially the order passed by the Financial Commissioner, Haryana, which was impugned by the petitioner in the writ petition, this Court is of the considered view that the matter, as disposed of in the light of the Instructions and the statement of the counsel as on 11.03.2019, requires to be recalled and the writ petition needs to be decided on its own merits.

Ordered accordingly.

Status quo as it existed with regard to possession on 11.03.2019 at the time of disposal of the writ petition shall be restored.

The writ petition is ordered to be listed for hearing on 18.08.2021 as per roster.”

In view thereof, no further order is required to be passed in the present contempt petitions.

Disposed of.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
