The petitioner herein has sought the relief of anticipatory bail in the criminal case arising out of the FIR bearing No.63 dated 10.06.2020 registered at Police Station Sadar, Faridkot, under Sections 379 and 186 IPC.

Learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Jasbir Singh from the above-said Police Station, apprises the Court that in compliance of the order dated 29.06.2020 as passed by the Co-ordinate Bench, the petitioner has joined in the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required and he is also not involved in any other criminal case of the similar nature and moreover, the Challan has already been presented in the Court.

Keeping in view the above-said submissions as made by learned State counsel, the instant petition is allowed and the relief of interim bail, as extended to the petitioner named Anit Singh @ Surinderpal Singh by the Co-ordinate Bench vide the said order dated 29.06.2020 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
