By this common order, the writ petitions, details of which have been given above, are being disposed of as both the writ petitions involve the same question of law on similar facts.

Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that petitioners were appointed on the posts of Art and Craft Teachers/Physical Training Instructors (PTI), which initial appointment of the petitioners was set-aside

by the Court being contrary to the law and the candidates were required to undergo a fresh selection process and the petitioners have again made the grade and have been selected on their respective posts in the said re-selection as well. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that as the petitioners have again been appointed, the benefit of service rendered by the petitioners in pursuance to the first selection be extended to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that the grievance, which has been raised by the petitioners, has already been raised by them in their representation/legal notice dated 12.05.2021 (Annexure P-12) in CWP No. 25874 of 2021 and representation dated 19.04.2022 (Annexure P-10) in CWP No. 9533 of 2022 and the petitioners will be satisfied, in case a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representations/legal notice in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Learned State counsel raises no objection for deciding their representations/legal notice in accordance with law within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, no further grievance of the petitioners survives and the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
