This is a petition seeking regular bail in case of FIR No.115 dated 16.11.2019, under Section 22 of NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Cantt. Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

One of the ground for seeking bail is that the trial is not proceeding at decent pace.

Learned State counsel on instructions submits that there are total nine prosecution witnesses and all the witnesses are official. One witness has been examined and remaining eight witnesses would be examined within four months from the date fixed before the trial Court.

In view of statement made by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner is not pressing the petition at this stage.

Dismissed as not pressed.

There is no doubt that in case a request is made before the Court concerned for accommodating the date for expeditious examination of prosecution witnesses, the same would be considered in accordance with law.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending application, if any is rendered infructuous.
