Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to the official respondents to conduct further investigation in FIR No.60 dated 09.07.2018 under Section 22/61/85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Bhadson, District Patiala.

It is stated in the petition that son of the petitioner along with two other boys were apprehended by the police in a false and fabricated case under NDPS Act.

This petition is pending since 2018 and on 17.01.2020, Superintendent of Police, Patiala was directed to file an affidavit, after re-verifying the investigation conducted so far.

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In compliance of the aforesaid order, affidavit of Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala is on record. As per this affidavit, the investigation was verified, after going through the record and examining the reply given by the DSP, Circle Nabha, District Patiala and CRWP-571-2018 titled as Charanjeet Kaur Vs. State of Punjab and the present petition are pending before this Court. It is further stated that the petitioner was also joined in re-verification of the investigation and his statement was recorded. After thorough investigation, it is found that investigation was properly conducted and report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.60 has already been submitted in the trial Court and even the charges have been framed on 13.01.2020 and the case is now fixed for recording the prosecution evidence. A copy of the inquiry report is attached with this affidavit as Annexure R-2/T.

In view of the above, no further action is called for in the present petition, as the matter is subjudice before the trial Court, as the charges have already been framed.

The petitioner is at liberty to raise all the pleas/defences during the course of trial.

Disposed of, accordingly.
