The present is a fourth petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.17 dated 15.02.2017, under Sections 365, 302, 201, 120-B and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sadar Bathinda, District Bathinda.

A perusal of the order dated 16.03.2022, passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Bathinda, would show that the statements of Kumkum Shukla and Triveni Shukla have been recorded during the course of investigation to the effect that present petitioner and Sailesh Kumar had abducted Vipin Kumar and murdered him and thereafter, they had also cut the dead body of Vipin Kumar into pieces and concealed the same by putting the same into polythenes. Neither the supplementary

statement of Kumkum Shukla, nor the statement of Triveni Shukla, have been annexed with the present petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition, at this stage, with liberty to file a fresh petition after studying the entire challan and after annexing all the relevant documents including the above-said statements of the said two witnesses.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, at this stage, with the aforesaid liberty.

Pending miscellaneous application, if any, stands disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
