A perusal of the file goes to show that appeal had been filed on behalf of the appellants by Sh. B.S. Bedi, Advocate whereas Sh. H.R. Bansal, Advocate had been appearing for respondent No.1-Bank. The matter had been referred to Permanent Lok Adalat to explore the possibility of amicable settlement, however, the parties failed to reach such settlement and file was sent back to this Court. Since then, the matter is pending. Nobody had appeared for appellants and for respondents No.1 and 2 in the Court on 01.02.2019. Similarly there was no representation on behalf of the appellants on 13.11.2019 as well as on 03.11.2022 and even today, no steps have been taken by the appellants for effecting service upon respondents No.3 to 5 at their correct addresses despite repeated directions issued by this Court. It seems that the appellants are not interested in further prosecution of the appeal. Accordingly, the same stands dismissed for non-prosecution.
