Complaining wilful violation of the order dated 07.03.2022, passed in Civil Writ Petition No.4382 of 2022, the present petition under Section 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, has been filed. The operative part of the order dated 07.03.2022, reads as under:-

“Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioners, the directions are issued to the respondent-authorities to duly consider the legal notice dated 25.01.2022 (Annexure P-3) of the petitioners and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

If the petitioners are held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment of granting the same, the relief be released to them without any delay.”

Mr. Nikhil Chopra, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, has informed the Bench that the representation, as directed, stands decided on 13.05.2022.

In view of the above, no further order is required to be passed.

Hence, the present contempt petition is disposed of.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
