The petitioner is aggrieved because respondents No.5 to 8 are not being proceeded against, even though, they have absented themselves from the meetings of the Gram Panchayat regularly. Even, legal notice dated 22.04.2022 (Annexure P-5) has failed to move the authorities. Instead, Administrator is being appointed for carrying out the functions of the Gram Panchayat as Resolution cannot be passed on account of absence of the aforementioned respondents. Thus, a direction may be issued to the official respondents to take appropriate action against the private respondents.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only.

Mr. Arun K. Kaundal, DAG, Punjab accepts notice and waives service.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, no reply is necessary.

The writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the pending legal notice dated 22.04.2022 (Annexure P-5) by passing a speaking order within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Till then, meeting of the Gram Panchayat will not be held.

A photocopy of this order be supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner under signature of the Bench Secretary of this Court.
