Prayer in this writ petition is for quashing order dated 29.04.2022, Annexure P-6, whereby petitioner was transferred from Government College for Women, Rohtak to Government College, Baroda, Sonapat, on the ground that such action is illegal as petitioner has not completed three years of service at District Rohtak.

The matter was adjourned to enable learned counsel for the petitioner to go through decision of the Division Bench of this High Court in LPA No. 247 of 2020, titled 'Nisha Vs. State of Haryana, d/d 24.02.2020, wherein it is specifically held that a transfer policy is not enforceable, as such. It is to be noted that no mala fides etc., have been argued or alleged in the writ petition. It is a settled position that transfer of an employee is the prerogative of the employee, with the latter not having a vested right to continue at a particular place of posting. The scope of judicial intervention in

these matters is admittedly limited.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw this writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to avail the remedy/remedies, as may be available to her in accordance with the applicable rules and regulations.

Writ petition is accordingly dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforementioned.
