Instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to the respondents not to interfere in the peaceful life of the petitioner and not to call the petitioner repeatedly for recording of the statement on the complaint submitted against her by her son Gurinder Singh Sandhu on account of his failed marriage and consequent fear and apprehension nurtured by him.

Ms. Amarjit Kaur Khurana, DAG Punjab on instructions from ASI Sucha Singh submits that the petitioner had never been called in reference to any complaint by the Police and that there is no occasion or reason to unnecessary call the petitioner to the Police Station.

In view of the statement so made by the learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the instant petition..
