Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that in the present case, grievance of the petitioners is that they were not granted the benefit of the 3rd ACP, for which they were entitled for keeping in view the letter dated 04.03.2014 (Annexure P-6), issued by the respondent-Department. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the benefit, as being claimed by the petitioners in the present petition, has already been extended to the other similarly situated employees by the respondent-Department, but the petitioners have been left out without any valid justification.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the same grievance has also been raised by the petitioners before respondents No.2 and 3 by filing representation dated 22.12.2021 (Annexure P-7), which is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned and the petitioners will be satisfied at this stage, in case direction is given to respondent No.2 to decide the said representation dated 22.12.2021 in a time bound manner, by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Raman Kumar Sharma, Additional A.G., Haryana, keeping in view the advance service of the copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the State and raises no objection, in case prayer made hereinbefore on behalf of the petitioners for deciding the representation dated 22.12.2021 (Annexure P-7) in a time bound manner is accepted.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case and without going into merits of the claim as raised by the petitioners in the present case as well as in the representation dated 22.12.2021 (Annexure P-7), this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to pass an appropriate speaking order on the representation dated 22.12.2021 (Annexure P-7), filed by the petitioners, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of the copy of this order.
