MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to take action on the representation dated 28.04.2022 moved by her.

Learned counsel has argued that the petitioner-Gurdeep Kaur had entered into an agreement to sell dated 05.10.2021 with Poonam Devi wife of Kamlesh Chaudhary for selling her house bearing No.56, Hargobind Nagar, Reru Jalandhar for a total sale consideration of Rs.15,50,000/- and against that a sum of Rs.2,50,000/- was received as earnest money and it was agreed that the remaining amount was to be paid on or before 05.12.2021. According to learned counsel, petitioner sold the property in order to arrange the money for the marriage of her daughter and the property was sold at below market price, because of the urgency of money. He has argued that since the deal did not mature for want of payment by Poonam Devi, she came to her house with unknown persons and used abusive language and asked for return of earnest money. He has further pointed out that now the

petitioner is being harassed at the instance of said purchaser-Poonam Devi, who has given various complaints against her in the police. He has drawn the attention of the Court to the representation dated 28.04.2022 (Annexure P-1) sent to Police Commissioner, Jalandhar, seeking protection of life and liberty, but no action has been taken upon the same. He prays for issuance of necessary directions.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by learned counsel that no cognizance has been taken by police upon the said complaint as no case has been registered so far.

Upon considering the above background and nature of the dispute between the parties and the fact that the petitioner has already submitted her reply to the police at this stage, this Court is not inclined to exercise inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Dismissed.
