AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This is a petition seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 81 dated 9.4.2022, under Section 21 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1988 (for short, 'the Act'), registered at Police Station Shahjadpur, District Ambala.

As per the case set up, acting upon a secret information , 5520 tablets of Diphenoxylate Hydrochloride, 2280 tablets of Alprozolam, 800 capsules of SPA-Parvion Plus and 260 tablets of Alprozolam were recovered from a house.

The contentions raised by learned counsel for the petitioner are that there is identity dispute as the petitioner is Sanjay Kumar and not Sanjay Singh, there is no mention in the FIR that the house belongs to the petitioner and no independent witness was joined while making the recovery in spite of the fact that family members of the petitioner were in the house.

After arguing for some time and realising that the contentions are not finding favour, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
