Through the present petition, the petitioner prays for issuance of direction to the respondents not to harass him by calling in the police station or implicate him in any false case at the behest of the ruling Government and further for issuance of 7 days advance notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C. and also to take action against respondent No. 4, who is giving him threats to register a false case against him.

Reply by way of affidavit dated 18.03.2019 of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Sri Hagobindpur, Police District Batala, already filed in the Registry, is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at an appropriate place.

Today, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

Learned State counsel points out that as per the aforesaid reply,
FIR No. 8 dated 19.03.2017, under Sections 452, 326, 324, 506, 379, 427,

148 and 148 IPC, on the statement of Malkiat Singh son of Hira Singh and FIR No. 59 dated 01.11.2017, under Sections 365, 342, 506, 323, 148 and 149 IPC, on the statement of Jaswant Singh son of Sawaran Singh, have been registered against the petitioner at Police Station Quadian. In FIR No. 59 dated 01.11.2017, the petitioner was arrested on 01.11.2017. Moreover, the petitioner is involved in four other FIRs.

Thus, keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is a habitual offender having criminal antecedents, this Court finds that the present petition bereft of any merit.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
