1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 31.08.2021, in CWP-16848-2021.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 31.08.2021, reveals that CWP-16848-2021, was disposed of by directing the official respondents to consider legal notice dated 19.05.2019 as representation moved by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and if there was no impediment for the release of payment, to release the same to the petitioner as per law without any delay.

3. Learned Addl. AG, Punjab, has produced copy of speaking order dated 12.01.2022 rejecting the claim of the petitioner. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the

petitioner does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 12.01.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
