VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for quashing of FIR No.127 dated 24.06.2017 registered under Sections 379B, 323, 148, 149, 120-B IPC at Police Station Machhiwara, Police District Khanna and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

On 19.05.2022, a coordinate Bench of this Court had directed the parties to record their statements before the learned trial Court / Illqa Magistratre in support of compromise and had also directed the Illqa Magistrate/ trial Court to submit its report. The Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana, in pursuance of the said order, has submitted its report to the effect that the complainant has not come present to record his statement.

The case has been called twice. No one has appeared on behalf of the parties.

In view of the above, it seems that the compromise has not

fructified and accordingly, the present petition is dismissed. However, liberty is granted to the parties to file a fresh petition for quashing of the above said FIR on the basis of compromise in case compromise is still effectual and parties are ready to get their statements recorded in respect of the compromise.

Pending miscellaneous application stands disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
