This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., for quashing of FIR No.72 dated 02.04.2013 under Sections 306/34 IPC 1860 registered at Sections 306/34 IPC 1860 registered at Police Station Nakodar, Jalandhar (Annexure P-1) at the instance of respondent No.2, on the basis of Compromise (Annexure P-2) effected between the parties.

Mr. B. D. Sharma, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf of legal heirs of Ashok Kumar Nayyar (deceased) and submits that there is no compromise between the petitioner and legal heirs of the deceased. Even, the petitioner did not make them party in the petition.

Given above, the present petition is not maintainable. Even the FIR in case under Section 306 IPC cannot be quashed on the basis of compromise in view of judicial pronouncements. Hence, the present petition is dismissed. Liberty is reserved to file a fresh petition on merits, if need so arise.
