Since the entire prosecution evidence has been led in the petitioner's trial, at this stage learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition and submits that he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Trial Court to expeditiously dispose of the petitioner's trial.

Learned State counsel submits that he has no objection if the above alternate prayer made on behalf of the petitioner is accepted.

After considering the totality of the facts of the present case and because every undertrial has a right to a speedy trial, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Trial Court to expeditiously dispose of the petitioner's trial in accordance with law.
