MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.85 dated 31.07.2021 under Sections 21, 22 and 29 Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Sadar Phagwara, District Kapurthala, who apprehends his arrest at the hands of Police.

On 07.05.2022, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel contends that the alleged recovery of contraband (15 gram heroin and 50 grams intoxicant substance) was effected from co-accused, who was arrested on the spot and at that time the petitioner was already in custody in case FIR No.129 dated 18.08.2020 under Sections 307, 506, 34, 120-B, 148, 149 and 201 IPC and Section 25 Arms Act, 1959 (Annexure P-2) registered at Police Station Bulhawal, District Hoshiarpur. According to him, subsequently on the basis of disclosure statement made by the co-accused, the petitioner has been implicated.

Notice of motion for 31.05.2022.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and

surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that in compliance of the above order, the petitioner associated himself in the investigation and cooperated during interrogation.

Learned State counsel who is instructed by ASI Sukhwinder Kumar states that indeed the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 07.05.2022 is made absolute.
