The petitioner has filed this 4th petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 282 dated 22.09.2019, registered under Sections 22/29/31 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that vide order dated 18.11.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioner was granted interim bail awaiting FSL report, which was not misused by the petitioner.

Learned State counsel submits that the recovery effected in the present case is commercial quantity and in another case under NDPS Act, the petitioner stands convicted.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner drawn the attention of this Court towards the order dated 02.02.2022, passed by this

Court in CRM-M-51350-2021, whereby direction was issued to the learned trial Court to make an endeavour to decide the case at the earliest and restricts her prayer to again direct the learned trial Court to conclude the trial within a stipulated period.

In view of the above, the petition is disposed and the learned trial Court is again directed to expedite and conclude the trial at the earliest, in accordance with law.
