Prayer in this petition, filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of directions to official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners as petitioner No.1 has performed marriage with petitioner No.2 against the wishes of her parents and other family members and the petitioners are apprehending threat to their life and liberty at their instance.

Ms. Suman Kumari, Advocate, who is present in Court on behalf of the private respondents, submits that petitioner No. 1 Nisha was earlier married to one Akashdeep, who is residing in Canada and without obtaining divorce, she has filed the present petition along with petitioner No. 2 by concealing the said fact.

In view of the same, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to file afresh with better particulars.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
