1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order Annexure P/2 dated 10.03.2022, in CWP-4790-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 dated 10.03.2022, reveals that CWP-4790-2022, was disposed of by directing the competent authority to look into the grievance of the petitioner as also contentions raised in the writ petition and take a decision in respect thereto in accordance with law within 30 days from the date of order.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has produced copy of order dated 02.07.2022, passed by the respondent in compliance with order dated 10.03.2022, in CWP-4790-2022 and states that in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and the same may be disposed of as such while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 02.07.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
