Prayer in the petition is for quashing of the FIR No. 07 dated 24.01.2016, registered under Sections 63, 65,68-A of the Copy Right Act, 1957, at Police Station Jamalpur, District Ludhiana, along with all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom as well as the Charge-sheet and order of framing charges.

Notice of motion was issued way back on 23.09.2016.

Learned State counsel has placed on record the order dated 06.07.2019 passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ludhiana, vide which the petitioner was declared a proclaimed offender. The copy of the order is taken on record as 'Mark-X'. He submits that the petitioner has yet not been arrested.

Since the petitioner has been declared a proclaimed offender, no case for grant of relief as prayed for is made out.

The petition is dismissed.
