The petitioner herein has sought the relief of anticipatory bail in the criminal case arising out of the FIR bearing No.137 dated 07.04.2021 registered at Police Station Purani Sabji Mandi, Rohtak, under Sections 406, 420, 506 read with Section 34 IPC.

At this Stage, Mr. Ankur Dua, Advocate has joined the proceedings on behalf of the complainant in this case and has forwarded his Power of Attorney to the Court through e-mail and the same has been placed on the file.

Learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Rajesh, from above-said police station, apprises the Court that in compliance of the order dated 27.05.2021 passed by the Co-ordinate Bench, the petitioner has joined in the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required and he is also not involved in any other criminal case of the similar nature.

In view of the afore-said submission as made by learned State counsel, the instant petition is allowed and the relief of interim bail, as extended to the petitioner by the Co-ordinate Bench vide the said order dated 27.05.2021, is hereby made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join in the investigation as and when required/called upon to do so and shall also strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
