Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that in the present case, the petitioner became entitled for promotion to the post of Assistant General Manager in the year 2015, but he was not promoted to the said post on the ground that there was some disciplinary proceedings pending against him. Learned counsel further argues that after the retirement of the petitioner, his pensionary benefits have also not been released to him by the respondents and that too, without giving any valid justification.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the disciplinary proceedings were decided by the respondents and petitioner is exonerated of the allegations, hence, the petitioner is entitled for promotion to the post of Assistant General Manager with effect from the date when the junior of the petitioner was promoted to the said post, with all consequential benefits.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by serving upon them a legal notice dated 20.12.2019 (Annexure P-8), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be

satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Raman Kumar Sharma, Additional Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection in deciding the legal notice dated 20.12.2019 (Annexure P-8) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the legal notice dated 20.12.2019 (Annexure P-8), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to decide the legal notice dated 20.12.2019 (Annexure P-8) within a period of 8 weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
