Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 195 dated 27.09.2019, registered under Sections 147, 149, 323, 341, 379, 356 IPC, at Police Station West, Sector-11, Chandigarh.

Vide order dated 09.05.2022, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 09.05.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned Addl. PP UT Chandigarh, on instructions from ASI Paramjeet Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation. The challan stands presented.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

As per the office report, the process fee has not been filed. Since the learned Addl. PP U.T. Chandigarh, is appearing in the case, there is no need to file the process fee.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 09.05.2022 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
