The prayer under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.157 dated 13.04.2022 under Sections 120-B, 379 and 420 IPC and Sections 61(1)(a) & 61(1)(c) of Excise Act registered at Police Station Chandimandir.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 07.05.2022 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 07.05.2022 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 07.05.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
