1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 25.01.2022, in CWP-26031-2021.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 25.01.2022, reveals that while issuing notice of motion for 18.02.2022, it was directed that no coercive steps be taken against the petitioner.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of order Annexure P/1 dated 25.02.2022, having been complied with, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
