Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.018 dated 11.03.2022, under Sections 323, 376(2)(n), 344, 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860; Section 6 of the Protection of the Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 and Section 9, 10 of Child Marriage Act, 2006, registered at Police Station Women Police Station Hansi.

Vide order dated 12.05.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that pursuant to order dated 12.05.2022, petitioners have joined the investigation and as such their interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from PSI Kavita, affirmed the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 12.05.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
