Learned Senior counsel for the petitioners argues that in the present petition, though, the claim of the petitioners for selection and consequent appointment has already been allowed by the respondents but the only grievance which remains is that the petitioners be also given the said benefit from the date, the similarly situated employees were given the same along with the consequential benefit of seniority and increment.

Learned State counsel submits that as of now nothing has come on record that the petitioners have not been offered the said benefit and in case petitioners file an appropriate representation claiming the said benefit, the same will be decided in accordance with law and as per the rules governing the service and an appropriate order will be passed by the authorities concerned within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of any such representation and in case after the decision, the petitioners are

found meritorious enough for the grant of said benefit, the same will be extended to them within a period of four weeks thereafter.

Learned Senior counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed off having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.

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Application also stands disposed off.
