This petition has been filed by the petitioner challenging Clause 4.8 in the tender notice issued by the authorities on 16.06.2020 (P-10). It is informed by learned counsel for the petitioner that the tender in question has already been awarded to the private respondents, who has completed most of the work.

In view of the aforesaid, it is submitted that the petition may be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. However, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the questions of law raised in the petition be kept open for a decision in appropriate proceedings.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition stands disposed of as infructuous by efflux of time, leaving the questions of law involved in the petition open for adjudication in appropriate proceedings.
