1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-2 dated 13.12.2021 in CWP-25208-2021.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-2 dated 13.12.2021 reveals that CWP-25208-2021 was disposed of by directing the competent authority to decide legal notice dated 13.10.2021 by passing a speaking order within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order .

3. Learned DAG, Haryana has filed a short reply dated 27.05.2022 alongwith Annexure R-1 dated 13.05.2022 rejecting the claim of the petitioner as contained in legal notice dated 13.10.2021. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal of the same states that in the circumstances, the petitioner does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order Annexure R-1 by way

of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

5. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
