The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.0150, dated 24.12.2021, under Sections 307, 452, 148, 149 and 506 IPC (offence under Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Division No.1, Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that pursuant to the order dated 11.05.2022, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for investigation of the case.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Satnam Singh corroborates the said averment and submits that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required for the purpose of investigation.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 11.05.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) CrPC.
