This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to the respondents to constitute a Special Investigation Team or to investigate the matter from any senior police officer in FIR no.68 dated 04.07.2018 registered under Sections 364, 120-B IPC at Police Station Cantt. Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that despite a lapse of more than 4 years, neither cancellation report nor challan has been presented in the present case. It is further submitted that the petitioner has given a representation (Annexure P-6) to the Inspector General of Police, District Ferozepur, Ferozepur. It is further submitted that the petitioner would be satisfied in case respondent no.5-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur Cantt, looks into the said representation and after considering the same, takes appropriate action therefrom, in accordance with law.

Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur Cantt. will look into the said representation, in accordance with law.

Keeping in view the above said facts and circumstances of the present case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.5-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur Cantt. to look into the representation (Annexure P-6), a copy of which will be supplied to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur Cantt. within a period of two weeks from today by the petitioner and after considering the same, take appropriate action, in accordance with law and also consider the final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. with respect to the FIR no.68 dated 04.07.2018 registered under Sections 364, 120-B IPC at Police Station Cantt. Ferozepur.

Pending miscellaneous application, if any, stands disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
