The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 for conducting a fair and impartial inquiry in Case FIR No.334 dated 22.09.2021 under Section 379 IPC and Section 3(i) of PDP Act (Prevention of damage to Public Property Act and Section 33 of Forest Act, registered at Police Station Chandhut, District Palwal along with other prayers as mentioned in the prayer clause.

Notices served upon the official respondent(s) through the State's counsel.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied in case directions may be issued to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Palwal to decide the representation dated 15.03.2022 (Annexure P-6) within time bound manner.

The petition is allowed to the extent mentioned above. Pending application, if any, stands disposed of.
