This is a petition that has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus to be issued to the respondent to recommend the name of the petitioner herein for the post of Constable (Male) under category No.1.

The petitioner herein had applied for the post of Constable (Male) pursuant to the advertisement No.03/2018 dated 16.04.2018. It was the case of the petitioner that he had the necessary educational qualifications and would have come into the zone of consideration, if he had been granted five marks under the socio-economic criteria, as there was no one from his family having a Government job.

Learned State counsel would submit that the necessary marks have been given to the petitioner herein and the Haryana Staff Selection

Commission (HSSC) has now recommended the name of the petitioner for appointment to the post of Male Constable against advertisement No.03/2018 under category No.1 vide recommendation letter No. HSSC/Confid/Recomm./2021/333 dated 25.07.2021 and his name stands reflected at serial No.15 in the recommendation list.

I have heard learned State counsel and have also perused the recommendation list dated 25.07.2021, which is taken on record.

In view of the fact that the name of the petitioner herein stands recommended by the Commission for appointment to the post of Male Constable vide its recommendation letter No. HSSC /Confid/ Recomm./ 2021/333 dated 25.07.2021, the instant petition is dismissed as having rendered infructuous.
