RAJESH BHARDWAJ, J. (Oral)

Prayer in the present petition is for quashing the FIR No.11 dated 24.02.2019, under Sections 406 and 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Nurmahal, District Jalandhar along with subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of oral compromise.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Nachhatar Singh, has informed that there are two petitioners in this case, out of which, petitioner No.2 is resident of UK and he has been declared Proclaimed Offender and the proceedings have been initiated against him.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the oral compromise arrived at between the parties.

It has been submitted by counsel for the complainant/respondent No.2 parties that the petition under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act was also filed. However, son of the petitioner did not even appear before those proceedings. He opposes the compromise as alleged.

As the petition has been filed on the basis of compromise and the same has been opposed by the counsel for complainant, so no releif as prayed for can be granted. The petition is disposed of with liberty to the parties to avail their alternative remedies as available to them under the law.
