AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition is filed seeking directions to official respondents to protect life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members from the hands of private respondents (arrayed in the petition). Further, direction is sought that petitioner and his family members were being called by SHO, Police Station City Moga on pretext of recording their statements.

The State had filed reply dated 5.10.2021. From the pleadings, it is forthcoming that it is a case of matrimonial dispute and parties are involved in number of litigations.

As per the reply filed by the State, the daughter of the petitioner is a doctor in Sawarghat District Bilaspur. The petitioner and private respondents are not residents of Punjab. It is further pleaded that the petitioner had not moved any application to the Sr. Superintendent of

Police, Moga with regard to the threat to the life of his daughter. Further, it is stated that whenever the daughter of the petitioner will come to Mohali and there is any threat apprehension and such an apprehension is given to the police authorities, needful action in accordance with law would be taken.

Learned counsel for respondents No. 4 to 7 submits that for the set of allegations, the daughter of the petitioner had filed private complaint and the proceedings of the complaint have been stayed by this Court and that fact has not been disclosed in this petition.

In view of the reply, no further directions are called for.

Petition is disposed of as infructuous.
