Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that though the benefits, for which the petitioner is entitled for, have already been extended in his favour, vide order dated 04.04.2022 (Annexure P-4), passed by respondent No.2, but even after expiry of four weeks of passing of the said order, the same has not been implemented so far by the respondents, and therefore, the respondents are liable to be directed to implement the said order dated 04.04.2022 (Annexure P-4) forthwith.
