However, liberty is reserved to the petitioner to make a motion before the learned Civil Judge concerned with an application under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2(A) CPC read with Section 151 CPC, seeking the taking of actions against the errant litigant(s) concerned, in the latter purportedly making breach of order of 24.03.2022, as, embodied in Annexure P-2, appended with the petition.

4. If the above remedy is resorted by the petitioner, the learned Civil Judge concerned is directed to make an expeditious adjudication thereons.
