**ANOOP CHITKARA J. (ORAL)**

The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. to grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.102 dated 13.09.2019, under Section 302 IPC registered at Police Station Bapoli, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the State has opposed the grant of bail to the petitioner on the ground that prosecution witnesses have been examined and this Court should not interfere at such a belated stage.

Confronted with this, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be contended and satisfied in case directions may be issued to learned trial Court to conclude the trial by the end of this year.
