[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 16.03.2021, in CRM-M No.879 of 2021.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1), reveals that CRM-M No.879 of 2021, was disposed of by directing the petitioner to appear before the learned trial Court on 22.03.2021 and on appearance, the petitioner was directed to be granted regular bail in offence under Section 302 IPC by the trial Court, subject to its satisfaction.

[3] Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the petitioner having been granted bail by the learned trial Court in respect of offence under Section 302 IPC, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition any further and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not

calling for any action against the respondent(s) under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
