It is submitted that there is no direct passage into the colony of the petitioner from the metro track and thus, the residents are facing great inconvenience. Oral requests have fallen on deaf ears. Legal notice dated 11.04.2022 (Annexure P-2) has also not been responded to. Thus, a direction may be issued to respondent No.5 to decide the pending legal notice within a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Arun K. Kaundal, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 5 and waives service.

At the asking of the Court, learned State counsel accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.2 to 4 as well and waives service.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, no reply is necessary.

The writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.5 to decide the pending legal notice dated 11.04.2022 (Annexure P-2) by passing a speaking order within 12 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
