Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., is for quashing of the FIR No. 381 dated 16.10.2012, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of the IPC and Sections 7 and 10 of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955 at Police Station Sadar Rohtak, District Rohtak.

Learned State counsel has brought to the notice of this Court that on 06.01.2015, the trial Court's record was summoned, however, the same has not yet been returned to the trial Court.
