[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order (Annexure P-1) dated 27.04.2021 in CWP No.9080 of 2021 in case titled as '**Sandeep Kumar and others** versus **State of Punjab and others.**'

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP No.9080 of 2021 was disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider legal notice dated 05.01.2021 as representation moved by the petitioners and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] On the previous date, learned Asstt. AG, had placed on record order dated 23.11.2021, rejecting the claim of the petitioners.

[4] Today, learned counsel for the petitioners states that in view

instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order dated 23.11.2021 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[5] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioners, as prayed for.
