The present writ petitions have been filed under Articles 226/227
of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of

Certiorari raising a challenge to the orders passed by respondent No.3 whereby the petitioners were removed from the Ad-hoc Committee/Executive Board of the Haryana Sikh Gurudwara Management Committee and it has been alleged that said order has been passed in contravention of the Haryana Sikh Gurudwaras (Management) Act, 2014.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-State contends that the present petitions have become infructuous because, at present, the grievance is only academic since the Ad-hoc Committee has been nominated after the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court upholding the Constitutional vires of the Haryana Sikh Gurudwaras (Management) Act, 2014 and the said Ad-hoc Committee shall thereafter elect the Executive Body of the Haryana Sikh Gurudwaras Committee.

The above factual aspect has not been controverted by the learned counsel for the petitioner(s).

Accordingly, the present petitions are disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
