The petitioners have approached this Court seeking protection of their life and liberty on the premise that petitioner No.1 has performed marriage with petitioner No.2 against the wishes of her parents and other family members and the petitioners are apprehending threat to their life and liberty at their instance.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Joginder Pal Ratra, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent – State while Mr. N.S. Sidhu, Advocate has appeared on behalf of respondent No.4.

On 09.05.2022, counsel appearing for respondent No.4/father of petitioner No.1, requested that the parents of petitioner No.1 want to meet petitioner No.1 in the Court and the parties were called. The case was sent to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court for recording the statement of petitioner No.1 and as per her

statement, it is stated that she do not want to go with her parents as she performed marriage with petitioner No.2 and she want to stay with him.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that a representation dated 05.05.2022 was made to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda (Annexure P6), seeking necessary protection but no action has been taken so far in the matter.

Heard.

Without examining the question of validity or otherwise of marriage of the petitioners, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda to look into grievance of the petitioners expressed in the representation (Annexure P6) and take appropriate action, if any, warranted in the circumstances.

The Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda – respondent No.2 is further directed to convene a meeting between the petitioners and the parents of petitioner No.1, if so required. It is further directed that petitioner No.1 will submit the complete address of her parents along with the mobile phone numbers to enable respondent No.2, to comply with the directions.
