FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

A petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (Annexure P2) filed by the husband Pardeep Kumar Puri (now respondent) against applicant Anku @ Ankita is pending in the Court of learned Principal Judge, Family Court, SBS Nagar and the wife through this invocation under Section 24 CPC had sought its transfer to Jalandhar.

It is not a matter of disagreement that SBS Nagar erstwhile Nawanshahar was carved out of Jalandhar and the distance between the two places is approximately 45 kms and both the towns are adjoining to each other where all types of transport facilities are available throughout the day being situated on the main GT road. It is a matter of common knowledge that such like petitions usually come up not for any substantial reasons but purely to satisfy sadistic pleasures of tormenting the other side. The Courts need to be wary of such machinations and to discourage misuse of the process of the Court. There is no exceptional

circumstance brought about necessitating intervention by this Court. The petition being without any merit stands dismissed in limine.
