1. Prayer made in the instant petition, cast under Section 482 Cr.P.C., for a direction being issued upon the official respondents to conduct a taint free, and, expeditious investigation(s), into the petition FIR bearing No. 0277 of 29.4.2017, registered at Police Station Nuh, District Mewat, does not survive, as the learned State counsel, on instructions given to him by SI Muni Lal, submits, that after termination of investigations, in to the FIR, the investigating officer concerned, has filed a closure report, before the learned Magistrate concerned, and, also when he further submits that the learned Magistrate concerned, has to yet draw a verdict, qua whether the protest made against its acceptance, by the complainant, and/or qua the cancellation report filed by the investigating officer concerned, is to be assigned credit.

2. In the face of the above, the petition is disposed of as becoming rendered infructuous.
